



New Programme in Genomic Medicine

Genomic technologies and information will transform practice across the clinical professions over the next decade. This programme has been developed to provide a multi-disciplinary and multi-professional course in genomics that can be applied to clinical practice and medical research. The programme leads to a Postgraduate Certificate, Diploma or Master's Degree in Genomic Medicine. Part-time and full-time options are available.

The course will provide directly relevant professional training and research in the field of genomics, educating suitably-qualified applicants to prepare for the future adoption of genomic technologies and the increasing use of genomic information as part of the diagnostic and treatment pathway.

Health Education England will fully fund course fees for NHS staff enrolling on the programme. The course is also highly relevant to others with an interest in research or healthcare in this exciting field.
